

Things to consider for fundraising and grants and the impact of our current lease.

I have stated that a longer lease comes with future building issues as follows and they have asked for quotes for all of these works to consider within the HoT.

I have outlined below some of the things that we have forecast as having 'structural' costs in the next few years: (This is not an exhaustive list).

Inspection and roof repairs

Due to the height of the roof, even to inspect the roof we would have to have complete scaffolding around the building, which would then identify any repairs and recommendations, including the flat roof above the entrance. However further investigation points to this being a condensation issue rather than a leak.

We have asked for access to WDC contractors to assist – they are a bit busy with RAAC atm.

Lobby roof repair/replacement

Flooring

– The linoleum flooring is the original flooring, this is starting to look rather tired and generally has a lifespan of around 20 years.

Automatic Doors

– Again these are the original doors, both automatic doors have been repaired recently and both are old models and further repairs would be very difficult. We would need to consider provisions for the these to be replaced at some point in the next 3-5 years

Court netting and fencing

– This will need a full replacement within the next 24 months, it has been repaired many times over the years and needs replacing.
