

Popup café – WRCC Grant successful to fund Christmas and Feb half term pop up café. Christmas holiday sessions, very successful, Friday session had 58 attendees. Need to seek funding to deliver Easter/May half term and summer holiday/Easter and

Christmas 24)

Community Dinners – National Grid Warm Hub grant successful to fund Jan/Feb/March dinners. In partnership with CK. CK have applied for Kind Food grant to fund the remainder of the year.

Board Games Hub – National Grid Warm Hub grant successful to fund until end of March. Need to source funding for remainder of year.

Pop Up Sports Café – Secured funding from National Grid Warm Hub grant to fund a pilot of 3 monthly sessions. Aimed at reducing social isolation and improving physical activity in partnership with CK. First café 8 Jan, no attendees, lack of promo due to Christmas. Next café Feb, so will need to market effectively. Similar running successfully in Balsall Common.

Iceland Vouchers – in partnership with CK – continuing to manage.

Breakfast Provision – in partnership with CK – continuing to manage.

Lunch Vouchers – in partnership with CK – continuing to manage. **One Off Events**
